

EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION
2015-EAB-1006

Affirmed
Disqualification

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On July 7, 2015, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding that the employer discharged claimant for an act that disqualified her from receiving benefits (decision # 120035). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On August 11, 2015, ALJ Triana conducted a hearing, and on August 13, 2015 issued Hearing Decision 15-UI-42945, affirming the Department's decision. On August 20, 2015, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

Claimant failed to certify that she provided a copy of her written argument to the other parties as required by OAR 471-041-0080(2)(a) (October 29, 2006). EAB therefore did not consider the argument when reaching this decision.

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 15-UI-42945 is affirmed.
