## EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2015-EAB-1071

Affirmed
Late Request for Hearing Denied
Disqualification

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On April 9, 2015, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding that the employer discharged claimant for misconduct (decision # 92253). On April 29, 2015, decision # 92253 became final without a request for hearing having been filed. On July 21, 2015, the Department served notice of an administrative decision (# 160034) assessing a \$1,408 overpayment based on decision # 92253. On August 3, 2015, claimant filed an untimely request for a hearing on decision # 92243 and timely request for hearing on decision # 160034. On September 2, 2015, ALJ S. Lee conducted hearings, and on September 4, 2015, issued the following hearing decisions: Hearing Decision 15-UI-43956, which dismissed claimant's hearing request on decision # 92253 as untimely; and Hearing Decision 15-UI-43992, which affirmed decision # 160034 (the overpayment decision). On September 8, 2015, claimant filed applications for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

Pursuant to OAR 471-041-0095 (October 29, 2006), EAB consolidated its review of Hearing Decisions 14-UI-43956 and 15-UI-43992. For case-tracking purposes, this decision is being issued in duplicate (EAB Decisions 2015-EAB-1071 and 2015-EAB-1072).

EAB reviewed both hearing records. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decisions under review are **adopted**.

**DECISION:** Hearing Decisions 15-UI-43956 and 15-UI-43992 are affirmed.
