## EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2015-EAB-1191

Affirmed Disqualification

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On August 18, 2015, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding that the employer discharged claimant, but not for misconduct (decision # 83727). The employer filed a timely request for hearing. On September 23, 2015, ALJ M. Davis conducted a hearing in which the claimant did not participate, and on September 24, 2015, issued Hearing Decision 15-UI-44809, concluding that the employer discharged claimant for misconduct. On October 6, 2015, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

**DECISION:** Hearing Decision 15-UI-44809 is affirmed.
