

EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION
2015-EAB-1466

Affirmed
Late Claim for Benefits Denied
Ineligible

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On October 7, 2015, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of two administrative decisions: decision # 92958, which concluded that claimant filed a late claim for benefits, and decision # 92605, which concluded that claimant did not actively seek work from July 26 through August 8, 2015 (weeks 30-15 and 31-15). Claimant filed timely hearing requests. On November 16, 2015, ALJ M. Davis conducted a consolidated hearing and issued Hearing Decision 15-UI-47719, which affirmed decision # 92605 concerning claimant's work search, and Hearing Decision 15-UI-47720 concerning claimant's late claim for benefits. On December 4, 2015, claimant filed applications for review of both hearing decisions with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

Pursuant to OAR 471-041-0095 (October 29, 2006), EAB consolidated its review of Hearing Decisions 15-UI-47719 and 15-UI-47720. For case-tracking purposes, this decision is being issued in duplicate (EAB Decisions 2015-EAB-1466 and 2015-EAB-1467).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decisions under review are **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decisions 15-UI-47719 and 15-UI-47720 are affirmed.
