EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2015-EAB-1482

Affirmed Request to Reopen Denied

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On October 6, 2015, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding that the employer discharged claimant for committing a disqualifying act (decision # 121750). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On October 21, 2015, the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) issued notice of a hearing scheduled for November 4, 2015. On November 4, 2015, ALJ Seideman issued Hearing Decision 15-UI-47182, dismissing claimant's hearing request for failure to appear at the hearing. Claimant filed a timely request to reopen. On November 16, 2015, the OAH mistakenly issued a decision purporting to dismiss claimant's request to reopen. By letter dated December 8, 2015, the OAH vacated the November 16 hearing decision and issued an amended hearing decision, Hearing Decision 15-UI-48963, which denied claimant's request to reopen. Also on December 8, 2015, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

Claimant failed to certify that he provided a copy of his argument to the other parties as required by OAR 471-041-0080(2)(a) (October 29, 2006). Therefore, we did not consider the argument when reaching this decision.

EAB reviewed the entire record in this case. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), Hearing Decision 15-UI-48963 is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 15-UI-48963 is affirmed.
