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## EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2015-EAB-1627

## Affirmed Disqualification

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On October 21, 2014, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant voluntarily left work without good cause (decision # 90419). On November 10, 2014, decision # 90419 became final without a request for hearing having been filed. On November 26, 2014, claimant filed an untimely request for hearing. On December 8, 2014, ALJ Kangas issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-29991, dismissing claimant's request for hearing as untimely, subject to claimant's "right to renew" the request by submitting a response to the "Appellant Questionnaire" attached to the hearing decision within 14 days of the date the decision was mailed.<sup>1</sup> On December 12, 2014, OAH received claimant's response. On December 30, 2014, ALJ Kangas issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-31041, re-dismissing claimant's November 26, 2014 request for hearing. On January 2, 2015, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

**DECISION:** Hearing Decision 14-UI-31041 is affirmed.
