PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On January 8, 2016, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of the following two administrative decisions: decision # 81548 concluded that claimant voluntarily left work without good cause and decision # 84019 concluded that claimant did not actively seek work from December 20 through 26, 2015 (week 51-15). Claimant filed timely hearing requests. On February 2, 2016, ALJ S. Lee conducted hearings on both hearing requests and issued Hearing Decision 16-UI-52569, affirming decision # 81548. On February 8, 2016, ALJ S. Lee issued Hearing Decision 16-UI-52565, concluding that claimant did not actively seek work from December 20 through 26, 2015. On February 11, 2015, claimant filed applications for review of both hearing decisions with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

Pursuant to OAR 471-041-0095 (October 29, 2006), EAB consolidated its review of Hearing Decisions 16-UI-52565 and 16-UI-52569. For case-tracking purposes, this decision is being issued in duplicate (EAB Decisions 2016-EAB-0149 and 2016-EAB-0150).

Claimant failed to certify that he provided a copy of his argument to the other parties as required by OAR 471-041-0080(2)(a) (October 29, 2006). Therefore, we did not consider the argument when reaching this decision.

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record in both cases. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decisions under review are **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decisions 16-UI-52565 and 16-UI-52569 are affirmed.
