

**EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION**  
**2016-EAB-0183**

*Affirmed*  
*Late Requests for Hearing Dismissed*

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On July 20, 2015, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding that claimant was overpaid \$256 in benefits that she is liable to repay (decision # 202020). On August 10, 2015, decision # 202020 became final without a request for hearing having been filed. On August 21, 2015, the Department served notice of an administrative decision concluding that she was overpaid \$512 in benefits that she is liable to repay (decision # 155225). On September 10, 2015, decision # 155225 became final without a request for hearing having been filed. Claimant filed late requests for hearing on both decisions. On February 4, 2016, ALJ Shoemake conducted a consolidated hearing, and on February 9, 2016 issued Hearing Decisions 16-UI-52582 and 16-UI-52583, dismissing claimant's late requests for hearing on decisions # 202020 and # 155225. On February 17, 2016, claimant filed applications for review of Hearing Decisions 16-UI-52582 and 16-UI-52583 with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

Pursuant to OAR 471-041-0095 (October 29, 2006), EAB consolidated its review of Hearing Decisions 16-UI-52582 and 16-UI-52583. For case-tracking purposes, this decision is being issued in duplicate (EAB Decisions 2016-EAB-0182 and 2016-EAB-0183).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decisions under review are **adopted**.

**DECISION:** Hearing Decisions 16-UI-52582 and 16-UI-52583 are affirmed.
