# EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2016-EAB-0383 

Affirmed<br>Ineligible Weeks 46-15 through 49-15, 51-15 and 52-15

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On February 8, 2016, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of two administrative decisions: decision \# 151525 concluded that claimant did not actively search for work from November 15 through December 12, 2015 (weeks 46-15 through 49-15) and from December 20, 2015 through January 2, 2016 (weeks 51-15 and 52-15); and decision \# 1509001 concluded that claimant was not available for all suitable work opportunities from December 20 through December 26, 2015 (week 51-15). On March 15, 2016, ALJ Wipperman conducted hearings, and on March 18, 2016, issued the following two hearing decisions: Hearing Decision 16-UI55265, which affirmed decision \# 151525, and Hearing Decision 16-UI-55341, which affirmed decision \# 150901. On March 31, 2016, claimant filed applications for review of both hearing decisions with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

Pursuant to OAR 471-041-0095 (October 29, 2006), EAB consolidated its review of Hearing Decisions 16-UI-55265and 16-UI-55341. For case-tracking purposes, this decision is being issued in duplicate (EAB Decisions 2016-EAB-0383 and 2016-EAB-0384).

EAB reviewed both hearing records. On de novo review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decisions under review are adopted.

DECISION: Hearing Decisions 16-UI-55265 and 16-UI-55341 are adopted.
