

EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION
2016-EAB-0427

Affirmed
Ineligible Weeks 4-16 through 7-16

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On February 18, 2016, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding that claimant had not registered for work as directed and was ineligible for benefits for week 4-16 (January 24 through 30, 2016). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On March 28, 2016, ALJ Shoemake conducted a hearing, and on April 4, 2016 issued Hearing Decision 16-UI-56390, concluding that claimant had not registered for work as directed and was ineligible for benefits for weeks 4-16 through 7-16 (January 24 through February 20, 2016). On April 11, 2016, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 16-UI-56390 is affirmed.
