

EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION
2016-EAB-0599

Affirmed
Ineligible Weeks 2-16 through 6-16

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On March 23, 2016, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision (decision # 74949) concluding that claimant failed to actively search for work from January 10 through February 20, 2016. Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On May 4, 2016, ALJ Murdock conducted a hearing, and on May 23, 2016, issued Hearing Decision 16-UI-58833, concluding that claimant did not actively search for work from January 10 through February 13, 2016 (weeks 2-16 through 6-16), but actively searched for work from February 14 through 20, 2016 (week 7-16). On May 23, 2016, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 16-UI-58833 is affirmed.
