

EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION
2016-EAB-0992

Affirmed
Late Request for Hearing Denied

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On February 8, 2016, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision (decision # 195122) disqualifying claimant from 52 weeks of unemployment benefits. On February 29, 2016, decision # 195122 became final without a request for hearing having been filed. On June 28, 2016, claimant filed an untimely request for hearing. On July 7, 2016, ALJ Kangas issued Hearing Decision 16-UI-63262, dismissing claimant's request for hearing subject to claimant's right to renew the request by responding to an appellant questionnaire within 14 days. Claimant timely responded to the appellant questionnaire. On August 16, 2016, ALJ Frank conducted a hearing and on August 19, 2016, issued Hearing Decision 16-UI-66009, re-dismissing claimant untimely request for hearing. On August 26, 2016, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire record in this case. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 16-UI-66009 is affirmed.
