## EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2016-EAB-1154

Affirmed
Overpayment and Penalties

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On January 5, 2012, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision assessing a \$3,034 overpayment, a \$455.10 monetary penalty, and 25 penalty weeks. On January 25, 2012, the administrative decision became final without a request for hearing having been filed. On August 5, 2016, claimant filed an untimely hearing request. On August 10, 2016, ALJ Kangas issued Hearing Decision 16-UI-65319, dismissing claimant's late request for hearing subject to claimant's right to renew her request by responding to an appellant questionnaire within 14 days. Claimant timely responded to the appellant questionnaire. By letter dated September 7, 2016, the Office of Administrative Hearings cancelled Hearing Decision 16-UI-65319. On October 5, 2016, ALJ M. Davis conducted a hearing, and on October 6, 2016, issued Hearing Decision 16-UI-78799, allowing claimant's late request for hearing and affirming the administrative decision. On October 14, 2016, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

No adversely affected party requested review of the portion of Hearing Decision 16-UI-78799 that concluded claimant had good cause for filing a late request for hearing. We therefore confined our review to the issues of claimant's overpayment.

EAB reviewed the entire record in this case. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

**DECISION:** Hearing Decision 16-UI-68699 is affirmed.
