## EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2016-EAB-1174

Affirmed No Disqualification

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On August 30, 2016, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding the employer discharged claimant for misconduct (decision # 85440). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On October 4, 2016, ALJ M. Davis conducted a hearing, at which the employer failed to appear, and on October 5, 2016 issued Hearing Decision 16-UI-68611, concluding claimant's discharge was not for misconduct. On October 19, 2016, the employer filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

In written argument, the employer asked for a new hearing on the grounds that its participants made an inadvertent scheduling error that caused them to miss the hearing. The employer's request for relief is construed as a request to have EAB consider additional evidence under OAR 471-041-0090 (October 29, 2006), which allows EAB to consider new information if the party offering the information shows it was prevented by circumstances beyond its reasonable control from presenting the information at the hearing. Because human error of the sort that cause the employer to miss the hearing is considered to be within a party's reasonable control to avoid, the employer's request to have EAB consider its additional evidence must be denied.

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

**DECISION:** Hearing Decision 16-UI-68611 is affirmed.
