

EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION
2017-EAB-0834

Affirmed
Late Request for Hearing Dismissed

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On November 10, 2016, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant did not actively seek work from October 2, 2016 to November 5, 2016 (decision # 134104). On November 30, 2016, decision # 134104 became final without claimant having filed a timely request for hearing. On June 15, 2017, claimant filed a late request for hearing by phone. On June 20, 2017, ALJ Kangas issued Hearing Decision 17-UI-86152, dismissing claimant's late request for hearing subject to her right to renew the request by responding to an appellant questionnaire within 14 days of the date the hearing decision was mailed. Claimant did not respond to the appellant questionnaire. On July 10, 2017, claimant filed a timely application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB). Claimant did not include any information with her application for review explaining why she filed a late request for hearing in this matter.

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 17-UI-86152 is affirmed.
