

EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION
2017-EAB-1003

Affirmed
Request to Reopen Denied

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On March 6, 2017, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant did not actively seek work during the weeks of January 8, 2017 through February 11, 2017 (decision # 123346). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On July 5, 2017, ALJ Turner convened a hearing at which claimant did not appear and issued Hearing Decision 17-UI-87210, dismissing claimant's request for hearing due to his failure to appear. On July 25, 2017, Hearing Decision 17-UI-87210 became final without claimant having filed a request to reopen the July 5, 2017 hearing. On August 1, 2017, claimant filed a late request to reopen the hearing. On August 3, 2017, ALJ Kangas issued Hearing Decision 17-UI-89601, denying claimant's request to reopen. On August 17, 2017, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB considered claimant's written argument when reaching this decision.

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 17-UI-89601 is affirmed.
