

EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION
2017-EAB-1093

Affirmed
Late Request for Hearing Dismissed

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On June 13, 2017, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding the claimant did not register for work as required and was therefore ineligible for benefits. On July 3, 2017, that decision became final without claimant having filed a timely request for hearing. On August 22, 2017, claimant filed a late request for hearing. On August 28, 2017, ALJ Kangas issued Hearing Decision 17-UI-91333, dismissing claimant's request for hearing subject to his right to renew the request by responding to an appellant questionnaire by September 11, 2017. On September 5, 2017, claimant responded to the appellant questionnaire. On September 7, 2017, ALJ Kangas reviewed claimant's response and issued Hearing Decision 17-UI-92091, re-dismissing claimant's late request for hearing. On September 13, 2017, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB considered claimant's written statements when reaching this decision.

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 17-UI-92091 is affirmed.
