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# EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2017-EAB-1203

#### Affirmed Disqualification

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On September 15, 2017, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding the employer discharged claimant for misconduct (decision # 121702). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On October 10, 2017, ALJ Hoppe conducted a hearing, and on October 11, 2017 issued Hearing Decision 17-UI-94286, affirming the Department's decision. On October 17, 2017, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB considered claimant's written argument when reaching this decision. Although the circumstances that led claimant to claimant's discharge were unfortunate and, to a certain extent, understandable, there is no doubt on this record that claimant deliberately violated the employer's policy with full knowledge that he was doing so, nor is there doubt that claimant ultimately violated the law. On the facts in this record, claimant must be disqualified from receiving benefits because of this discharge for the reasons set forth in Hearing Decision 17-UI-97286 and adopted herein.

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

### **DECISION:** Hearing Decision 17-UI-94286 is affirmed.
