## EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2017-EAB-1325

Affirmed
Request to Reopen Denied

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On August 17, 2017, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding that claimant quit working for the employer without good cause (decision # 134926). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On August 30, 2017, the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) served notice of a hearing scheduled for September 13, 2017. On September 13, 2017, claimant failed to appear at the hearing, and ALJ S. Lee issued Hearing Decision 17-UI-92480 dismissing claimant's request for hearing due to her failure to appear. On September 27, 2017, claimant filed a timely request to reopen the hearing. On October 24, 2017, ALJ S. Lee conducted a hearing, and on October 26, 2017 issued Hearing Decision 17-UI-95504, denying claimant's request. On November 13, 2017, claimant filed a timely application for review of Hearing Decision 17-UI-95504 with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

Claimant submitted written argument with her application for review, but failed to certify that she provided a copy of her argument to the other parties as required by OAR 471-041-0080(2)(a) (October 29, 2006). Therefore, we did not consider the argument when reaching this decision.

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

**DECISION:** Hearing Decision 17-UI-95504 is affirmed.
