

EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION
2017-EAB-1400

Affirmed
No Disqualification

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On September 20, 2017, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding the employer discharged claimant but not for misconduct (decision # 152403). The employer filed a timely request for hearing. On November 6, 2017, ALJ Griffin conducted a hearing, and on November 7, 2017 issued Hearing Decision 17-UI-96318, affirming the Department's decision. On November 25, 2017, the employer filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

The employer failed to certify that it provided a copy of its argument to the other parties as required by OAR 471-041-0080(2)(a) (October 29, 2006). Therefore, we did not consider the argument when reaching this decision. Even if we had, the outcome of this decision would remain the same for the reasons explained in Hearing Decision 17-UI-96318.

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 17-UI-96318 is affirmed.
