## EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2017-EAB-1465

Affirmed Requests to Reopen Allowed Eligible Week 30-17, Ineligible Weeks 31-17 to 32-17

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On September 7, 2017, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant did not actively seek work from July 23, 2017 to August 13, 2017 (decision # 95857). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On September 25, 2017, the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) mailed notice of a hearing scheduled for October 9, 2017, at which claimant failed to appear. On October 10, 2017, ALJ Amesbury issued Hearing Decision 17-UI-94110, dismissing claimant's hearing request for failure to appear. On October 14, 2017, claimant filed a request to reopen the October 9<sup>th</sup> hearing. On October 25, 2017, OAH mailed notice of a hearing scheduled for November 8, 2017, at which claimant failed to appear. On November 8, 2017, ALJ Amesbury issued Hearing Decision 17-UI-96399, dismissing claimant's hearing request for failure to appear. On November 13, 2017, claimant filed a request to reopen the November 8<sup>th</sup> hearing. On November 27, 2017, OAH mailed notice of a hearing scheduled for December 11, 2017. On December 11, 2017, ALJ Murdock conducted a hearing, at which claimant appeared, and on December 12, 2017 issued Hearing Decision 17-UI-98847, allowing claimant's requests to reopen the October 9<sup>th</sup> and November 8<sup>th</sup> hearings, and concluding that claimant did actively seek work from July 23, 2017 to July 29, 2017 (week 30-17) and was eligible for benefits that week, but did not actively seek work from July 30, 2017 to August 13, 2017 (weeks 31-17 to 32-17) and was ineligible for benefits for those weeks. On December 19, 2017, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record and claimant's argument to the extent it was relevant and based upon evidence in the hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

**DECISION:** Hearing Decision 17-UI-98847 is affirmed.
