EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2018-EAB-0352

Affirmed Ineligible

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On March 1, 2018, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant did not actively seek work from February 11, 2018 to February 24, 2018 (decision # 73327). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On March 28, 2018, ALJ Lewis conducted a hearing, and on March 29, 2018 issued Order No. 18-UI-106217, affirming the Department's decision. On April 10, 2018, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

Claimant's argument contained information that was not part of the hearing record, and failed to show that factors or circumstances beyond claimant's reasonable control prevented claimant from offering the information during the hearing. Under ORS 657.275(2) and OAR 471-041-0090 (October 29, 2006), we considered only information received into evidence at the hearing when reaching this decision. Even if we had considered the new information the outcome of this decision would remain the same, because the new information in claimant's argument did not establish that claimant performed a minimum of five work seeking activities during each of the weeks at issue that involved at least two direct contacts each week with employers and three other activities each week.

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the Order under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Order No. 18-UI-106217 is affirmed.
