

EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION
2018-EAB-0369

Affirmed
Disqualification

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On February 7, 2018, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding the employer discharged claimant for misconduct (decision # 75358). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On March 21, 2018, ALJ Murdock conducted a hearing, and on March 23, 2018 issued Order No. 18-UI-105862, concluding that claimant quit working for the employer without good cause. On April 11, 2018, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. Claimant submitted a brief written argument with her application for review, but failed to certify that she provided a copy of her argument to the other parties as required by OAR 471-041-0080(2)(a) (October 29, 2006). We therefore did not consider the argument when reaching this decision.

On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), Order No. 18-UI-105862 is **adopted**.

DECISION: Order No. 18-UI-105862 is affirmed.
