

EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION
2018-EAB-0405

Affirmed
Disqualification

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On March 6, 2018, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding that claimant quit working for the employer without good cause (decision # 82834). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On April 3, 2018, ALJ Amesbury conducted a hearing, and on April 4, 2018 issued Order No. 18-UI-106578, affirming the Department's decision. On April 23, 2018, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB considered the entire hearing record. Claimant submitted written argument with her application for review, but failed to certify that she provided a copy of her argument to the other parties as required by OAR 471-041-0080(2)(a) (October 29, 2006). EAB therefore did not consider the argument when reaching this decision. However, even if EAB had considered claimant's argument, the outcome of this decision would have remained the same for the reasons set forth in Order No. 18-UI-106578.

On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), Order No. 18-UI-106578 is **adopted**.

DECISION: Order No. 18-UI-106578 is affirmed.
