EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2018-EAB-0611

Affirmed Disqualification

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On April 9, 2018, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant voluntarily left work without good cause (decision # 93237). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On May 24, 2018, ALJ Amesbury conducted a hearing at which the employer failed to appear, and on May 25, 2018, issued Order No. 18-UI-110110, affirming the Department's decision. On June 14, 2018, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

Claimant's application for review included a written argument. In her argument, claimant asserted that her hearing was unfair because the ALJ focused his questioning on only one of her reasons for quitting and did not allow her to discuss her other reasons for leaving her employment. We reviewed the hearing record in its entirety, particularly the ALJ's findings, conclusions and analysis contained in his order which shows that the ALJ inquired fully into all of the matters at issue and gave claimant a reasonable opportunity for a fair hearing as required by ORS 657.270(3) and OAR 471-040-0025(1) (January 11, 2018). We also considered claimant's remaining arguments, to the extent they were based on the hearing record, when reaching this decision.

On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the Order under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Order No. 18-UI-110110 is affirmed.
