

EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION
2018-EAB-0653

Affirmed
Request to Reopen Denied

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On April 10, 2018, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant voluntarily left work without good cause (decision # 153812). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On April 30, 2018, the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) mailed notice of a hearing scheduled for May 14, 2018, at which time claimant failed to appear. On May 14, 2018, ALJ Schmidt issued Order No. 18-UI-109327, dismissing claimant's hearing request for failure to appear. On May 31, 2018, claimant filed a request to reopen that did not include a statement explaining why he failed to appear at the May 14th hearing. On June 7, 2018, ALJ Kangas issued Order No. 18-UI-110895, denying claimant's request to reopen. On June 26, 2018, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Order No. 18-UI-110895 is affirmed.
