PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On July 23, 2018, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served two notices of two administrative decisions, one concluding that claimant voluntarily left work without good cause (decision # 152815), and the other assessing a \$3,020 overpayment, \$453 monetary penalty, and 20 penalty weeks (decision # 194845). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing on both decisions. On August 27, 2018, ALJ S. Lee conducted two hearings. On September 4, 2018, the ALJ issued Order No. 18-UI-115985, affirming decision # 152815, and Order No. 18-UI-116009, affirming the Department's assessment of a \$3,020 overpayment in decision # 194845, but concluding that claimant was not subject to a monetary penalty or penalty weeks. On September 24, 2018, claimant filed an application for review of both Orders with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

Pursuant to OAR 471-041-0095 (October 29, 2006), EAB consolidated its review of Order Nos. 18-UI-115985 and 18-UI-116009. For case-tracking purposes, this decision is being issued in duplicate (EAB Decisions 2018-EAB-0933 and 2018-EAB-0934).

EAB reviewed both hearing records and claimant's written argument. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the Orders under review are **adopted**.

DECISION: Order Nos. 18-UI-115985 and 18-UI-116009 are affirmed.
