

**EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION**  
**2018-EAB-1116**

*Affirmed*  
*Disqualification*

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On October 16, 2018, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant voluntarily left work without good cause (decision # 81643). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On November 19, 2018, ALJ Wymer conducted a hearing, and on November 20, 2018, issued Order No. 18-UI-120049, affirming the Department's decision. On December 3, 2018, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

**FINDINGS OF FACT:** (1) Employer employed claimant as an environmental services aide from February 20, 2017 to June 19, 2018.

(2) The employer considered claimant to be a part-time employee, although near the end of her employment she worked closer to full time hours due to staffing issues. Claimant earned \$11.17 per hour working for the employer.

(3) Claimant became dissatisfied with working for the employer because she often became ill which she attributed, at least in part, to working in a medical facility among individuals who were sick and members of the general public who often came there to visit. She began seeking work with other employers in the manufacturing industry.

(4) At the beginning of June 2018, claimant believed she had obtained a job with a manufacturing company, MCX. MCX told claimant that the job she had applied for paid \$11.25 per hour and would require 40 hour work weeks. On June 4, 2018, claimant notified the employer in writing that she "had another position" and that her last day working for the employer would be "June 18 or thereabouts." Audio Record ~ 39:45 to 40:30. Claimant left her job with the employer effective June 19, 2018.

(5) After claimant's last day with the employer, while she "was going through final process of interviews" with MCX, there was a fire at the MCX facility where claimant thought she would be working, which halted production at that facility. Consequently, MCX never actually hired claimant.

**CONCLUSIONS AND REASONS:** We agree with the ALJ. Claimant voluntarily left work without good cause.

A claimant who leaves work voluntarily is disqualified from the receipt of benefits unless she (or he) proves, by a preponderance of the evidence, that she had good cause for leaving work when she did. ORS 657.176(2)(c); *Young v. Employment Department*, 170 Or App 752, 13 P3d 1027 (2000). If an individual quits work to accept an offer of other work, good cause exists only if the offer is definite, and the offered work is to begin in the shortest length of time as can be deemed reasonable under the individual circumstances, is reasonably expected to continue, and pays an amount equal to or in excess of the weekly benefit amount, or greater than the work left. OAR 471-030-0038(5)(a) (January 11, 2018).

Here, claimant quit work to accept an offer of manufacturing work from MCX, which she believed was forthcoming and would begin shortly after she quit. However, claimant admitted at hearing that after she left the employer, the job offer from MCX “fell through” due to a fire which occurred while she was going through “the final process of interviews.” Audio Record ~ 30:15 to 31:30. Accordingly, because her job offer was not yet “definite” at the time she left work with the employer, under OAR 471-030-0038(5)(a), claimant did not have good cause to quit work to accept it.

Claimant voluntarily left work without good cause and is disqualified from receiving unemployment insurance benefits until she has earned at least four times her weekly benefit amount from work in subject employment.

**DECISION:** Order No. 18-UI-120049 is affirmed.
