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EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2020-EAB-0555

Affirmed Late Request for Hearing Dismissed

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On November 25, 2019, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant failed to disclose a material fact to the Department and was overpaid \$481 in benefits claimant was required to repay to the Department (decision # 112825). On December 16, 2019, decision # 112825 became final without claimant having filed a timely request for hearing. On April 17, 2020, claimant filed a late request for hearing. On July 9, 2020, ALJ Kangas issued Order No. 20-UI-151987, dismissing claimant's late request for hearing subject to claimant's right to renew the request by responding to an appellant questionnaire by July 23, 2020. On July 25, 2020, claimant filed a late response to the appellant questionnaire and a timely application for review of Order No. 20-UI-151987 with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB). On July 30, 2020, ALJ Kangas mailed a letter stating that because claimant's response to the questionnaire was late, the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) would not consider it or issue another order, and Order No. 20-UI-151987 remained in effect. This matter is before EAB based upon claimant's timely application for review of Order No. 20-UI-151987.

EVIDENTIARY MATTER: EAB has considered additional evidence when reaching this decision under OAR 471-041-0090(1) (May 13, 2019). The additional evidence is claimant's response to the appellant questionnaire, which has been marked as EAB Exhibit 1, and a copy provided to the parties with this decision. Any party that objects to our admitting EAB Exhibit 1 into the record must submit such objection to this office in writing, setting forth the basis of the objection in writing, within ten days of our mailing this decision. OAR 471-041-0090(2). Unless such objection is received and sustained, the exhibit will remain in the record.

FINDING OF FACT: (1) On November 25, 2019, the Department mailed decision # 112825 to claimant's address on file with the Department. Claimant received the decision on December 3, 2019. EAB Exhibit 1. Decision # 112825 stated, "If you disagree with the amount of the overpayment, you have the right to appeal this decision. Any appeal must be filed on or before December 16, 2019 to be timely." Exhibit 1.

CONCLUSIONS AND REASONS: Claimant's late request for hearing on decision # 112825 is dismissed.

ORS 657.269 provides that the Department's decisions become final unless a party files a request for hearing within 20 days after the date the decision is mailed. ORS 657.875 provides that the 20-day deadline may be extended a "reasonable time" upon a showing of "good cause." OAR 471-040-0010 (February 10, 2012) provides that "good cause" includes factors beyond an applicant's reasonable control or an excusable mistake, and defines "reasonable time" as seven days after those factors ceased to exist. OAR 471-040-0010(1)(b)(B) also provides that good cause does not include not understanding the implications of a decision or notice when it is received.

The deadline for claimant to file a timely request for hearing on decision # 112825 expired on December 16, 2019. The record shows that claimant filed his request for hearing on April 17, 2020. Even assuming that claimant filed his request for hearing on January 15, 2020, as he asserted in his late response to the appellant questionnaire, claimant's request for hearing would still have been late. EAB Exhibit 1. Claimant stated in his late response to the appellant questionnaire that the reason he did not file his request for hearing before the deadline for a timely appeal was, "I thought that this matter had been resolved because I had spoken to a representative [and] explained I had made an input error [and] they scolded me and corrected it." EAB Exhibit 1. Claimant also asserted that he "thought the matter had been settled and that demand for payment was an error." EAB Exhibit 1.

Decision # 112825 stated, "If you disagree with the amount of the overpayment, you have the right to appeal this decision. Any appeal must be filed on or before December 16, 2019 to be timely." Claimant's appellant questionnaire response shows that when claimant received the decision, he disagreed with the decision amount because he thought the matter that caused the overpayment had already been resolved. Claimant's questionnaire response does not show that assuming the decision was a mistake was a factor beyond his reasonable control that prevented him from requesting a hearing by December 16, 2019. It was within claimant's reasonable control to contact the Department for assistance to verify if the decision was a mistake and to request a hearing because he disagreed with the overpayment amount in the decision. In addition, although claimant asserted that his failure to file a timely request for hearing was the result of a mistake on his part, it was not an "excusable mistake" within the meaning of the administrative rules because it does not, for example, raise a due process issue, and the record fails to show that it was the result of inadequate notice, reasonable reliance on another, or the inability to follow directions despite substantial efforts to comply.

Because claimant failed to establish good cause to extend the deadline for filing a request for hearing on decision # 112825, his late request for hearing is dismissed, leaving decision # 112825 undisturbed.

DECISION: Order No. 20-UI-151987 is affirmed.
