EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2021-EAB-0758

Affirmed
Late Claim for Benefits Denied

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On June 28, 2021, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding that claimant filed late claims for unemployment insurance benefits for the weeks including April 18, 2021 through May 29, 2021 (weeks 16-21 through 21-21) and was denied benefits for those weeks (decision # 120221). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On August 31, 2021, ALJ Frank conducted a hearing, and on September 2, 2021 issued Order No. 21-UI-173862, affirming decision # 120221. On September 22, 2021, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

FINDINGS OF FACT: (1) On March 30, 2020, claimant filed an initial claim for unemployment insurance benefits with a first effective week of March 29, 2020 through April 4, 2020 (week 14-20).

- (2) Prior to May 8, 2021, claimant did not attempt to restart her claim for benefits or claim weekly benefits for the weeks of April 18, 2021 through May 1, 2021 (weeks 16-21 through 17-21).
- (3) On May 15, 2021, claimant attempted to use the Department's online claims system to restart her claim for benefits so that she could then file a continued claim for the week of May 2, 2021 through May 8, 2021 (week 18-21). Claimant spent four hours inputting the requested data into the system, but when she attempted to submit her request to restart her claim, the system timed out and deleted the data she had entered. Claimant ultimately did not restart her claim.
- (4) On May 17, 2021, claimant again attempted to use the Department's online claims system to restart her claim so that she could then file a continued claim for the weeks including May 2, 2021 through May 15, 2021 (weeks 18-21 through 19-21). Claimant again spent four hours inputting the requested data, but this time repeatedly hit the "edit" button in an attempt to have the system save her data as she entered it. When claimant attempted to submit her request to restart her claim, the system again timed out and deleted the data she had entered. Claimant ultimately did not restart her claim.
- (5) On May 22, 2021, claimant again attempted to use the Department's online claims system to restart her claim for benefits so that she could then file a continued claim for the weeks including May 2, 2021

through May 15, 2021 (weeks 18-21 through 19-21). Claimant spent six hours inputting the requested data into the system. When claimant attempted to submit her request to restart her claim, the system told her that she had successfully submitted her request and that she would receive written notice of a decision within 21 days.

(6) On June 7, 2021, claimant contacted the Department to seek assistance with filing her weekly claims for benefits. At that time, a Department representative assisted claimant in claiming benefits for the weeks including April 18, 2021 through May 29, 2021 (weeks 16-21 through 21-21). These are the weeks at issue. The Department did not pay claimant benefits for any of the weeks at issue.

CONCLUSIONS AND REASONS: Claimant filed late claims for benefits for weeks 16-21 through 21-21 and is not entitled to benefits for those weeks.

OAR 471-030-0045 (January 11, 2018) provides, in relevant part:

- (1) As used in these rules, unless the context requires otherwise:
 - (a) "Continued Claim" means an application that certifies to the claimant's completion of one or more weeks of unemployment and to the claimant's status during these weeks. The certification may request benefits, waiting week credit, or non-compensable credit for such week or weeks. A continued claim must follow the first effective week of an initial, additional or reopen claim, or the claimant's continued claim for the preceding week[.]

* * *

- (4) A continued claim must be filed no later than seven days following the end of the week for which benefits, waiting week credit, or noncompensable credit, or any combination of the foregoing is claimed, unless:
 - (a) The continued claim is for the first effective week of the benefit year, in which case the week must be claimed no later than 13 days following the end of the week for which waiting week credit is claimed[.]

* * *

None of the weeks at issue was the first effective week of claimant's benefit year. Therefore, under OAR 471-030-0045(4), her continued claims for benefits for weeks 16-21, 17-21, 18-21, 19-21, 20-21 and 21-21 were due by May 1, 2021, May 8, 2021, May 15, 2021, May 22, 2021, May 29, 2021, and June 5, 2021, respectively.

The record shows that claimant made, at the very least, an effort to file a claim for weeks 18-21 through 19-21 by the timely filing deadline, but that she was prevented from doing so by the Department's online claims system. However, OAR 471-030-0045(4) contains no good-cause exception for failing to file a timely continued claim. Therefore, because she filed late claims for the weeks at issue, claimant is not entitled to benefits for those weeks.

DECISION: Order No. 21-UI-173862 is affirmed.
