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EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2022-EAB-0348

Affirmed Late Request for Hearing Dismissed

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On September 8, 2020, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served, by mail, notice of an administrative decision concluding that claimant voluntarily quit work without good cause and was disqualified from receiving unemployment insurance benefits effective April 5, 2020 (decision # 124042). On September 28, 2020, decision # 124042 became final without claimant having filed a request for hearing. On September 29, 2021, claimant filed a late request for hearing. ALJ Kangas considered claimant's request, and on December 14, 2021 issued Order No. 21-UI-181826, dismissing claimant's request for hearing as late, subject to claimant's right to renew the request by responding to an appellant questionnaire by December 28, 2021. On December 31, 2021, claimant filed a late response to the appellant questionnaire and a timely application for review of Order No. 21-UI-181826 with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB). On March 15, 2022, ALJ Kangas mailed a letter stating that the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) would not consider claimant's questionnaire response or issue another order regarding this matter because claimant's questionnaire response was late. This matter comes before EAB based upon claimant's December 31, 2021 application for review of Order No. 21-UI-181826.

EVIDENTIARY MATTER: EAB has considered additional evidence when reaching this decision under OAR 471-041-0090(1) (May 13, 2019). The additional evidence consists of claimant's response to the appellant questionnaire, and has been marked as EAB Exhibit 1, and a copy provided to the parties with this decision. Any party that objects to our admitting EAB Exhibit 1 must submit such objection to this office in writing, setting forth the basis of the objection in writing, within ten days of our mailing this decision. OAR 471-041-0090(2). Unless such objection is received and sustained, the exhibit will remain in the record.

FINDINGS OF FACT: (1) On September 8, 2020, the Department, served, by mail, decision # 124042 to claimant's address on file with the Department. Decision # 124042 stated, "You have the right to appeal this decision if you do not believe it is correct. Your request for appeal must be received no later than September 28, 2020." Exhibit 1 at 2.

(2) Claimant received decision # 124042. On September 29, 2021, claimant filed a late request for hearing on decision # 124042.

CONCLUSIONS AND REASONS: Claimant's late request for hearing is dismissed.

ORS 657.269 provides that the Department's decisions become final unless a party files a request for hearing within 20 days after the date the decision is mailed. ORS 657.875 provides that the 20-day deadline may be extended a "reasonable time" upon a showing of "good cause." OAR 471-040-0010 (February 10, 2012) provides that "good cause" includes factors beyond an applicant's reasonable control or an excusable mistake, and defines "reasonable time" as seven days after those factors ceased to exist.

On September 8, 2020, the Department served, by mail, notice of administrative decision # 124042 to claimant's address of record on file with the Department. The 20-day deadline for claimant to file a timely request for hearing on decision # 124042 was September 28, 2020. Claimant did not file a request for hearing on decision # 124042 until September 29, 2021. As such, claimant's request for hearing was late.

In their appellant questionnaire response, claimant first stated that they filed their request for hearing "before the deadline" in "August 2020" during a telephone conversation with the Department. EAB Exhibit 1 at 3. This statement suggests that claimant received decision # 124042 at some point in August 2020. However, August 2020 was prior to the September 8, 2020 date that the Department mailed decision # 124042. Therefore, claimant could not have receive decision # 124042 in August 2020.

Claimant also stated as part of their appellant questionnaire response that they "[did] not know exactly when [they] received" decision # 124042, but that they believed "it was late 2020 or early 2021." EAB Exhibit 1 at 1. However, there is a presumption that a letter duly directed and mailed was received in the regular course of the mail. ORS 40.135(1)(q). Claimant's inconsistent statements as to when they received decision # 124042, fail to overcome that presumption. Further, even if it is assumed that claimant first received decision # 124042 in "early 2021," they did not show why their request for hearing was not filed within the seven-day reasonable time period after receipt, but instead was filed several months later on September 29, 2021.

It can be inferred from claimant's appellant questionnaire response that their ability to request a hearing prior to the September 28, 2020 deadline may have been impacted by their full-time schooling, their work schedule, and their attempts to take care of their health. EAB Exhibit 1 at 3. However, these responses do not show that claimant was delayed in filing the request for hearing due to factors beyond their control. Although claimant's failure to file a timely request for hearing was likely the result of a mistake on claimant's part, claimant did not show that it was an "excusable mistake" within the meaning of the administrative rules because it did not, for example, raise a due process issue, and was not the result of inadequate notice, reasonable reliance on another, or the inability to follow directions despite substantial efforts to comply.

Therefore, claimant's late request for hearing on decision #124042 is dismissed.

DECISION: Order No. 21-UI-181826 is affirmed.
