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# EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2023-EAB-0388

#### Late Application for Review Dismissed

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On February 11, 2021, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of a determination for Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA) concluding that claimant was not entitled to PUA benefits effective February 2, 2020. On March 3, 2021, the PUA determination became final without claimant having filed a request for hearing.

On November 16, 2021, the Department served notice of an administrative decision concluding that claimant was unable to work from October 10 through 16, 2021 and was ineligible for benefits for that week and until the reason for the denial had ended (decision # 65233). On November 17, 2021, the Department served notice of an administrative decision concluding that claimant quit working for Prestige Care Inc. without good cause, and that claimant was disqualified from receiving benefits effective July 18, 2021 (decision # 92119). On December 6, 2021, decision # 65233 became final without claimant having filed a request for hearing. On December 7, 2021, decision # 92119 became final without claimant having filed a request for hearing.

On December 20, 2021, the Department served notice of an administrative decision denying claimant's request to backdate their claim to September 13, 2020, and concluding that claimant was denied benefits for the weeks from September 13 through November 7, 2020 (decision # 84928). Also on December 20, 2021, the Department served notice of an administrative decision denying claimant's request to backdate their claim to November 8, 2020, and concluding that claimant was denied benefits for the weeks from November 8, 2020 through January 2, 2021 (decision # 91920). Also on December 20, 2021, the Department served notice of an administrative decision denying claimant's request to backdate their claim to March 21, 2021, and concluding that claimant was denied befits for the weeks from March 21 through April 17, 2021 (decision # 92823). On January 10, 2022, decisions # 84928, 91920 and 92823 became final without claimant having filed a request for hearing.

On April 7 and 8, 2022, claimant filed late requests for hearing on the February 11, 2021 PUA determination and decisions # 65233, 92119, 84928, 91920 and 92823. ALJ Kangas considered claimant's late requests for hearing, and on April 26, 2022 issued Order Nos. 22-UI-192231, 22-UI-192230, 22-UI-192229, 22-UI-192248, 22-UI-192233 and 22-UI-192227, dismissing the requests for hearings subject to claimant's right to renew the requests by responding to an appellant questionnaire by

May 10, 2022. On May 16, 2022, Orders No. 22-UI-192231, 22-UI-192230, 22-UI-192229, 22-UI-192248, 22-UI-192233 and 22-UI-192227 became final without claimant having responded to the appellant questionnaire or filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

On March 31, 2023, claimant filed a late application for review of Orders No. 22-UI-192231, 22-UI-192230, 22-UI-192229, 22-UI-192248, 22-UI-192233 and 22-UI-192227 with EAB. Pursuant to OAR 471-041-0095 (October 29, 2006), EAB consolidated its review of Orders No. 22-UI-192231, 22-UI-192230, 22-UI-192229, 22-UI-192248, 22-UI-192233 and 22-UI-192227. For case-tracking purposes, this decision is being issued in sextuplicate (EAB Decisions 2023-EAB-0388, 2023-EAB-0387, 2023-EAB-0386, 2023-EAB-0390, 2023-EAB-0389 and 2023-EAB-0385).

**EVIDENTIARY MATTER:** EAB has considered additional evidence when reaching this decision under OAR 471-041-0090(1) (May 13, 2019). The additional evidence is claimant's application for review and written statement, and has been marked as EAB Exhibit 1, and a copy provided to the parties with this decision. Any party that objects to our admitting EAB Exhibit 1 must submit such objection to this office in writing, setting forth the basis of the objection in writing, within ten days of our mailing this decision. OAR 471-041-0090(2). Unless such objection is received and sustained, the exhibit(s) will remain in the record.

**FINDING OF FACT:** Orders No. 22-UI-192231, 22-UI-192230, 22-UI-19229, 22-UI-192248, 22-UI-192233 and 22-UI-192227, mailed to claimant on April 26, 2022, stated, "You may appeal this decision by filing the attached form Application for Review with the Employment Appeals Board within 20 days of the date that this decision is mailed." Orders No. 22-UI-192231, 22-UI-192230, 22-UI-19229, 22-UI-192248, 22-UI-192233 and 22-UI-192227 at 2. Orders No. 22-UI-192231, 22-UI-192230, 22-UI-19229, 22-UI-19229, 22-UI-192233 and 22-UI-192227 at 2. Orders No. 22-UI-192231, 22-UI-192230, 22-UI-19229, 22-UI-19229, 22-UI-192233 and 22-UI-192227 at 30 stated on their Certificates of Mailing, "Any party may appeal this Order by filing a Request for Review with the Employment Appeals Board no later than May 16, 2022." Order No. 22-UI-192248 stated on its Certificate of Mailing, "Any appeal from this Order must be filed on or before May 16, 2022 to be timely."

**CONCLUSIONS AND REASONS:** Claimant's late application for review of Orders No. 22-UI-192231, 22-UI-192230, 22-UI-192229, 22-UI-192248, 22-UI-192233 and 22-UI-192227 is dismissed.

An application for review is timely if it is filed within 20 days of the date that the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) mailed the order for which review is sought. ORS 657.270(6); OAR 471-041-0070(1) (May 13, 2019). The 20-day filing period may be extended a "reasonable time" upon a showing of "good cause." ORS 657.875; OAR 471-041-0070(2). "Good cause" means that factors or circumstances beyond the applicant's reasonable control prevented timely filing. OAR 471-041-0070(2)(a). A "reasonable time" is seven days after the circumstances that prevented the timely filing ceased to exist. OAR 471-041-0070(2)(b). A late application for review will be dismissed unless it includes a written statement describing the circumstances that prevented a timely filing. OAR 471-041-0070(3).

The application for review of Orders No. 22-UI-192231, 22-UI-192230, 22-UI-192229, 22-UI-192248, 22-UI-192233 and 22-UI-192227 was due May 16, 2022. Because claimant did not file their application for review until March 31, 2023, the application for review was late. Claimant provided a written statement with the application for review. However, claimant's written statement only described

circumstances that led claimant to file their late application for review. The written statement did not describe circumstances that prevented claimant from filing an application for review on time. Accordingly, claimant did not show good cause for the late application for review, and their late application for review is dismissed.

**DECISION:** The application for review of Orders No. 22-UI-192231, 22-UI-192230, 22-UI-192229, 22-UI-192248, 22-UI-192233 and 22-UI-192227 filed March 31, 2023 is dismissed. Orders No. 22-UI-192231, 22-UI-192230, 22-UI-192229, 22-UI-192248, 22-UI-192233 and 22-UI-192227 remain undisturbed.
