EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2024-EAB-0114

Reversed & Remanded

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On December 29, 2022, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding that claimant failed to provide information in accordance with the Department's rules and was denied benefits for the weeks from December 4 through 24, 2022 (weeks 49-22 through 51-22) and until the reason for the denial ended (decision # 614544). On January 18, 2023, decision # 614544 became final without claimant having filed a request for hearing. On February 9, 2023, claimant filed a late request for hearing. ALJ Kangas considered claimant's request, and on June 28, 2023 issued Order No. 23-UI-228900, dismissing the request as late, subject to claimant's right to renew the request by responding to an appellant questionnaire by July 12, 2023. On July 17, 2023, claimant filed a late response to the appellant questionnaire and a timely application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB). On February 6, 2024, ALJ Scott mailed a letter to claimant stating that because the appellant questionnaire response was late, it would not be considered and another order would not be issued regarding the matter. This matter comes before EAB based upon claimant's July 17, 2023 application for review of Order No. 23-UI-228900.

EVIDENTIARY MATTER: EAB has considered additional evidence when reaching this decision under OAR 471-041-0090(1) (May 13, 2019). The additional evidence is claimant's appellant questionnaire response and has been marked as EAB Exhibit 1, and a copy provided to the parties with this decision. Any party that objects to our admitting EAB Exhibit 1 must submit such objection to this office in writing, setting forth the basis of the objection in writing, within ten days of our mailing this decision. OAR 471-041-0090(2). Unless such objection is received and sustained, the exhibit will remain in the record.

FINDING OF FACT: (1) Decision # 614544, mailed to claimant on December 29, 2022, stated, "You have the right to appeal this decision if you do not believe it is correct. Your request for appeal must be received no later than January 18, 2023." Exhibit 1 at 2.

CONCLUSIONS AND REASONS: Order No. 23-UI-228900 is set aside and the matter remanded for a hearing to determine whether claimant's late request for hearing should be allowed and, if so, the merits of decision # 614544.

ORS 657.269 provides that the Department's decisions become final unless a party files a request for hearing within 20 days after the date the decision is mailed. ORS 657.875 provides that the 20-day deadline may be extended a "reasonable time" upon a showing of "good cause." OAR 471-040-0010 (February 10, 2012) provides that "good cause" includes factors beyond an applicant's reasonable control or an excusable mistake, and defines "reasonable time" as seven days after those factors ceased to exist.

The deadline for filing a request for hearing on decision # 614544 was January 18, 2023. Because claimant filed their request for hearing on February 9, 2023, the request was late. Claimant stated in their appellant questionnaire response, "I was notified I had not been denied, the information was transfering [sic] from ID.me." EAB Exhibit 1 at 9. Claimant further explained, "I was unaware this [filing a request for hearing] needed to be completed as I had been notified via phone I had completed the process and would obtain payment anytime." EAB Exhibit 1 at 10. These statements suggest that claimant may have received incorrect information from the Department which led claimant to believe that decision # 614544 would be reversed by the Department without claimant requesting a hearing, or that a hearing request had been filed by claimant calling the Department. If so, this may have constituted a factor beyond claimant's reasonable control or an excusable mistake that prevented timely filing. Further development of the record is therefore necessary to determine whether claimant's late request for hearing should be allowed.

On remand, inquiry should be made into what information the Department provided claimant regarding whether decision # 614544 could be or would be reversed without claimant requesting a hearing, or whether claimant was told that a hearing request had been filed during one or more of their telephone calls. This inquiry should include information in the Department's records or other sources about communications with claimant from December 29, 2022, when decision # 614544 was issued, through February 9, 2023, when the late request for hearing was filed. If good cause is shown to extend the deadline for timely filing, further inquiry should be made into when the factors that prevented timely filing ceased, and whether claimant's request for hearing was filed within a "reasonable time" thereafter.

For these reasons, Order No. 23-UI-228900 is set aside and the matter remanded for a hearing to determine whether claimant's late request for hearing should be allowed and, if so, the merits of decision # 614544.

DECISION: Order No. 23-UI-228900 is set aside, and this matter remanded for further proceedings consistent with this order.
