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EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2024-EAB-0465

Reversed & Remanded

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On February 9, 2024, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding that claimant voluntarily quit work without good cause and was therefore disqualified from receiving unemployment insurance benefits effective October 1, 2023 (decision # 130100). On February 29, 2024, decision # 130100 became final without claimant having filed a request for hearing. On April 10, 2024, claimant filed a late request for hearing. ALJ Kangas considered the request, and on May 13, 2024 issued Order No. 24-UI-254014, dismissing the request as late, subject to claimant's right to renew the request by responding to an appellant questionnaire by May 27, 2024. On May 28, 2024, claimant filed a late response to the appellant questionnaire and a timely application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EVIDENTIARY MATTER: EAB has considered additional evidence when reaching this decision under OAR 471-041-0090(1) (May 13, 2019). The additional evidence is claimant's appellant questionnaire response and has been marked as EAB Exhibit 1, and a copy provided to the parties with this decision. Any party that objects to our admitting EAB Exhibit 1 must submit such objection to this office in writing, setting forth the basis of the objection in writing, within ten days of our mailing this decision. OAR 471-041-0090(2). Unless such objection is received and sustained, the exhibit will remain in the record.

FINDING OF FACT: (1) Decision # 130100, mailed to claimant's address of record on file with the Department on February 9, 2024, stated, "You have the right to appeal this decision if you do not believe it is correct. Your request for appeal must be received no later than February 29, 2024." Exhibit 1 at 2.

CONCLUSIONS AND REASONS: Order No. 24-UI-254014 is set aside and the matter remanded for a hearing to determine whether claimant's late request for hearing should be allowed and, if so, the merits of decision # 130100.

ORS 657.269 provides that the Department's decisions become final unless a party files a request for hearing within 20 days after the date the decision is mailed. ORS 657.875 provides that the 20-day deadline may be extended a "reasonable time" upon a showing of "good cause." OAR 471-040-0010

(February 10, 2012) provides that "good cause" includes factors beyond an applicant's reasonable control or an excusable mistake, and defines "reasonable time" as seven days after those factors ceased to exist.

The request for hearing on decision # 130100 was due by February 29, 2024. Claimant filed their request for hearing on April 10, 2024, and it was therefore filed late. However, claimant's appellant questionnaire response suggests that claimant may have good cause for the late filing, and further development of the record is therefore warranted.

Claimant wrote in their appellant questionnaire response that they received decision # 130100 prior to the timely filing deadline. EAB Exhibit 1 at 1. Claimant asserted that they filed a timely appeal of that decision, explaining that they "specifically stated to [a Department representative] I was requesting a hearing via email on February 29, 2024 because I had no other way to submit it." EAB Exhibit 1 at 2. It is therefore possible that a timely request for hearing was filed. In the alternative, if an unsuccessful attempt to timely file a request for hearing delayed actual filing of the request to April 10, 2024, this may have been due to a factor beyond claimant's reasonable control or an excusable mistake that could support good cause to allow a late appeal.

On remand, inquiry should be made into the dates and contents of email communications between claimant and the Department or Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) from the date decision # 130100 was issued through April 10, 2024, as well as whether any of claimant's emails¹ could be construed as a timely request for hearing, whether claimant had reason to believe that a request for hearing had been timely filed though such a request was not actually filed, and whether any other circumstances that prevented timely filing constituted a factor beyond claimant's reasonable control or an excusable mistake. Further, if good cause is found to extend the deadline for timely filing, additional inquiry should be made into when the factors that prevented timely filing ceased and whether the late request for hearing was filed within a seven-day "reasonable time" after the factors ceased.

For these reasons, Order No. 24-UI-254014 is set aside and the matter remanded for a hearing to determine whether claimant's late request for hearing should be allowed and, if so, the merits of decision # 130100.

DECISION: Order No. 24-UI-254014 is set aside, and this matter remanded for further proceedings consistent with this order.

The parties may also offer any other relevant evidence in accordance with those instructions.
