EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2024-EAB-0840

Affirmed
Late Request for Hearing Dismissed Without Prejudice

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On September 3, 2024, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding that claimant voluntarily quit work without good cause and therefore was disqualified from receiving unemployment insurance benefits effective April 7, 2024 (decision # L0005847305). On September 23, 2024, decision # L0005847305 became final without claimant having filed a request for hearing. On October 3, 2024, claimant filed a late request for hearing on decision # L0005847305. ALJ Kangas considered claimant's request, and on November 20, 2024, issued Order No. 24-UI-274030, dismissing claimant's request for hearing as late, subject to claimant's right to renew the request by responding to an appellant questionnaire by December 4, 2024. On December 9, 2024, claimant filed a timely application for review of Order No. 24-UI-274030 with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EVIDENTIARY MATTER: EAB has considered additional evidence when reaching this decision under OAR 471-041-0090(1) (May 13, 2019). The additional evidence consists of claimant's written statement enclosed with the application for review, and has been marked as EAB Exhibit 1, and a copy provided to the parties with this decision. Any party that objects to our admitting EAB Exhibit 1 must submit such objection to this office in writing, setting forth the basis of the objection in writing, within ten days of our mailing this decision. OAR 471-041-0090(2). Unless such objection is received and sustained, the exhibit will remain in the record.

FINDING OF FACT: (1) On September 3, 2024, the Department mailed decision # L0005847305 to claimant's address on file with the Department. Decision # L0005847305 stated, "You have the right to

appeal our decision and request a hearing if you believe our decision is wrong. We must receive your request for a hearing no later than **September 23, 2024**." Exhibit 1 at 2 (emphasis in original).

CONCLUSIONS AND REASONS: Claimant's late request for hearing is dismissed without prejudice.

ORS 657.269 provides that the Department's decisions become final unless a party files a request for hearing within 20 days after the date the decision is mailed. ORS 657.875 provides that the 20-day deadline may be extended a "reasonable time" upon a showing of "good cause." OAR 471-040-0010 (February 10, 2012) provides that "good cause" includes factors beyond an applicant's reasonable control or an excusable mistake, and defines "reasonable time" as seven days after those factors ceased to exist.

The request for hearing on decision # L0005847305 was due by September 23, 2024. Because claimant did not file their request for hearing until October 3, 2024, the request was late. Claimant did not file a response to the appellant questionnaire or otherwise provide information to explain why their request for hearing was late. As such, claimant has not shown that they had good cause for filing the late request for hearing. Therefore, claimant's late request for hearing on decision # L0005847305 must be dismissed under ORS 657.875 and OAR 471-040-0010.

The above notwithstanding, claimant indicated on their statement enclosed with the application for review that they did not receive a copy of the ALJ's order until after the December 4, 2024, deadline to submit a response to the appellant questionnaire had passed. EAB Exhibit 1 at 1. This suggests that claimant might not have had sufficient opportunity to explain why they filed their late request for hearing. If claimant believes they have good cause for filing the late request for hearing, and filed the late request for hearing within a reasonable time, claimant may submit a completed Appellate Questionnaire, or ask EAB to reconsider this decision under OAR 471-041-0145 (May 13, 2019).

EAB will dismiss any request for reconsideration that does not include all five of the following:

- 1. Claimant must file the request for reconsideration by January 27, 2025, and
- 2. Claimant must state in the request for reconsideration that they sent a copy of the request to the other party, *and*
- 3. Claimant must provide additional specific details about the reason they filed a late request for hearing. For example, claimant should include specific information about the date they received decision # L0005847305, whether they read and disagreed with it, and how they were prevented from filing their request for hearing by September 23, 2024. Claimant should include specific details that might help EAB determine whether or not claimant had "good cause," which means factors beyond their reasonable control prevented them from filing a timely request for hearing, and
- 4. Claimant must provide the date the circumstances that prevented them from filing a timely request for hearing ended (the circumstances they listed in response to #3, above), *and*

5. Claimant must provide sufficient information to prove that they filed their request for hearing within **seven** days of the date the circumstances that prevented them from filing a timely application for review ended.

There are several ways to file a request for reconsideration:

- 1. Use your smart phone, tablet, or computer to fill out the "File a Written Argument" form, available on EAB's website: https://www.oregon.gov/EMPLOY/EAB/Pages/default.aspx, or

- 4. Send EAB a fax at 503-378-2129.

Please note that you need only file *one* request for reconsideration.

DECISION: Order No. 24-UI-274030 is affirmed.
