**EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION**  
**2025-EAB-0196**

*Affirmed*  
*Late Request for Hearing Dismissed*  
*No Justiciable Controversy*

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY AND FINDINGS OF FACT:** On January 3, 2025, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding that claimant was not denied benefits for the period of December 20, 2024, through January 3, 2025, a school recess period, because claimant did not have reasonable assurance of returning to work after the break period (decision # L0008017597). On January 23, 2025, decision # L0008017597 became final without claimant having filed a request for hearing. On February 20, 2025, claimant filed a late request for hearing. ALJ Kangas considered claimant's request, and on March 11, 2025, issued Order No. 25-UI-285631, dismissing claimant's late request for hearing because it presented no justiciable controversy. On March 20, 2025, claimant filed an application for review of Order No. 25-UI-285631 with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

**CONCLUSIONS AND REASONS:** Claimant's request for hearing presents no justiciable controversy and is dismissed.

OAR 471-040-0035 (August 1, 2004) states, in relevant part:

\* \* \*

(3) On the administrative law judge's own initiative, an administrative law judge may order that a request for hearing be dismissed if:

\* \* \*

(e) The request for hearing is made by a person not entitled to a hearing on the merits or is made with respect to a determination or decision of the Director or authorized representative with respect to which there is no lawful authority to request a hearing.

On January 3, 2025, the Department issued decision # L0008017597, which was fully favorable to claimant in that it did not deny claimant benefits. Claimant did not assign error to any portion of decision # L0008017597 itself or request reversal of that decision in their request for hearing, and alleged no facts entitling them to further relief in this matter.

Oregon courts follow the principle that a review on appeal may only be provided for justiciable controversies. *See, e.g., Gortmaker v. Seaton*, 252 Or. 440, 442, 450 P.2d 547 (1969). A justiciable controversy exists when the interests of the parties to the action conflict with each other, and the appeal will have some practical effect on the rights of the parties to the controversy. *Barcik v. Kubiacyk*, 321 Or 174, 895 P2d 765 (1995). To show a practical effect on their rights, an appellant must seek “substantive relief” through their appeal. *Krisor v. Henry*, 256 Or. App. 56, 300 P.3d 199 (Or. Ct. App. 2013).

The order under review correctly determined that a hearing on this matter would have no practical effect on claimant’s rights, and that it therefore presents no justiciable controversy. Order No. 25-UI-285631 at 2. As such, the order under review properly dismissed claimant’s request for hearing under OAR 471-040-0035(3)(e).

The above aside, claimant stated on their request for hearing that they wished to “appeal the decision to deny [their] ongoing weekly unemployment claims” in relation to their having been away for the last two weeks of June. Exhibit 2 at 4. Because the administrative decision at issue in *this* matter only addresses claimant’s eligibility for benefits during a school recess period in late December 2024 and early January 2025, it appears that claimant’s statement on the request for hearing refers to a matter addressed in one or more *other* administrative decisions.

The Department’s records show that two other administrative decisions were issued in September 2024, both of which *did* deny claimant benefits. One of these decisions (decision # L0006225474) denied claimant benefits because claimant did not respond to an inquiry regarding being out of the country for a period of time in August 2024. Claimant filed a late request for hearing on that decision, and the matter (UI Case No. 2024-UI-26585) is currently pending before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). The other decision (decision # L0006187968) denied claimant benefits on the basis that they failed to actively seek work for the week of August 25, 2024, through August 31, 2024. Department records do not show that claimant filed a request for hearing on decision # L0006187968. To the extent that claimant wishes to challenge the outcomes in either of these two additional decisions, claimant may wish to contact either OAH, regarding decision # L0006225474 that is currently pending before them, or the Oregon Employment Department regarding decision # L0006187968, which has not been appealed.

**DECISION:** Order No. 25-UI-285631 is affirmed.
