

**EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION**  
**2026-EAB-0060**

*Late Application for Review Dismissed*

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On August 8, 2025, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding that the employer discharged claimant for misconduct and claimant was disqualified from receiving unemployment insurance benefits effective June 8, 2025 (decision # L0012279422).<sup>1</sup> On August 28, 2025, decision # L0012279422 became final without claimant having filed a request for hearing. On October 15, 2025, claimant filed a late request for hearing on decision # L0012279422.

ALJ Kangas considered claimant's request, and on December 23, 2025 issued Order No. 25-UI-315193, dismissing claimant's request for hearing as late, subject to claimant's right to renew the request by responding to an appellant questionnaire by January 6, 2026. On January 12, 2026, Order No. 25-UI-315193 became final without claimant having filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB). On January 13, 2026, claimant filed a late response to the appellant questionnaire and a late application for review of Order No. 25-UI-315193 with EAB.

**EVIDENTIARY MATTER:** EAB has considered additional evidence when reaching this decision under OAR 471-041-0090(1) (May 13, 2019). The additional evidence consists of claimant's application for review of Order No. 25-UI-315193 and the postmarked envelope in which claimant sent their application for review to EAB. The additional evidence has been marked as EAB Exhibit 1 and a copy has been sent to the parties with this decision. Any party that objects to our admitting EAB Exhibit 1 must submit such objection to this office in writing, setting forth the basis of the objection in writing, within ten days of our mailing this decision. OAR 471-041-0090(2). Unless such objection is received and sustained, the exhibit will remain in the record.

<sup>1</sup> Decision # L0012279422 said that claimant was denied benefits from June 8, 2025 to May 16, 2026. However, decision # L0012279422 should have said that claimant was disqualified from receiving benefits beginning Sunday, June 8, 2025 and until they earned four times their weekly benefit amount. *See* ORS 657.176.

**FINDING OF FACT:** (1) Order No. 25-UI-315193, mailed to claimant on December 23, 2025, stated, “You may appeal this decision by filing the attached form Application for Review with the Employment Appeals Board within 20 days of the date that this decision is mailed.” Order No. 25-UI-315193 at 2. Order No. 25-UI-315193 also stated on its Certificate of Mailing, “Any party may appeal this Order by filing a Request for Review with the Employment Appeals Board no later than January 12, 2026.”

**CONCLUSIONS AND REASONS:** Claimant’s late application for review of Order No. 25-UI-315193 is dismissed.

An application for review is timely if it is filed within 20 days of the date that the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) mailed the order for which review is sought. ORS 657.270(6); OAR 471-041-0070(1) (May 13, 2019). The 20-day filing period may be extended a “reasonable time” upon a showing of “good cause.” ORS 657.875; OAR 471-041-0070(2). “Good cause” means that factors or circumstances beyond the applicant’s reasonable control prevented timely filing. OAR 471-041-0070(2)(a). A “reasonable time” is seven days after the circumstances that prevented the timely filing ended. OAR 471-041-0070(2)(b). A late application for review will be dismissed unless it includes a written statement describing the circumstances that prevented a timely filing. OAR 471-041-0070(3).

The filing date for an application for review filed by mail is the postmark date on the envelope in which the application was mailed. OAR 471-041-0065(1)(b) (May 13, 2019). The postmark date on the envelope in which claimant mailed their application for review was January 13, 2026; that date is therefore the filing date. The application for review of Order No. 25-UI-315193 was due January 12, 2026. Because claimant did not file their application for review until January 13, 2026, the application for review was late. EAB Exhibit 1. Although claimant submitted a late appellate questionnaire response to explain why they filed a late request for hearing on decision # L0012279422, claimant’s application for review to EAB did not include a written statement describing the circumstances that prevented claimant from filing the application for review by the January 12, 2026 deadline. Accordingly, claimant did not show good cause for the late application for review, and claimant’s late application for review is dismissed.

**DECISION:** The application for review filed January 13, 2026 is dismissed. Order No. 25-UI-315193 remains undisturbed.
